
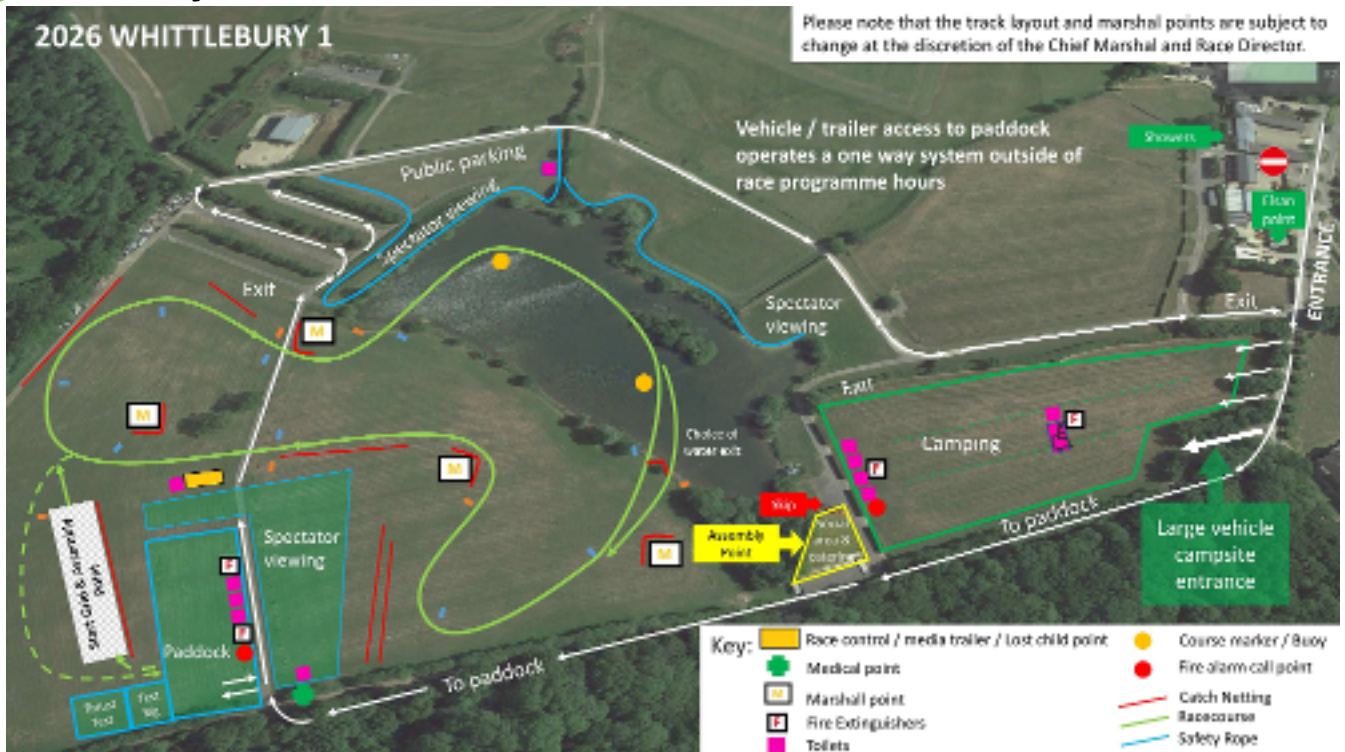

Site Guidelines

Please keep pets on leads at all times and follow the camping lanes plan. HCGB Site Fee wristbands to be worn at all times - Generators off by 23:00. No music in the campsite at night after 23:00hrs - BBQ's and firepits are to be raised off the ground. Please study site layout for fire call points, extinguisher location

Fire Assembly Points are located at the social area and also one on the grid.

There is a strict one way route into and out of the paddock and camping area as per the site layout map. Access to the camping area for vehicles is from the top and not from the social area.

Paddock Guidelines

Smoking or E Cigarettes are not to be used in the paddock area - Operate craft at walking speed only. Children between the ages of 4 and 10 to be supervised at all times in the paddock, children under 4 are not permitted in the paddock during racing - Hot work and welding only in specified areas. Maximum of 40 litres of fuel per craft to be stored in suitable containers. Engines off time at 1800h.

Via the M1:

At junction 15A, take the A43 exit towards Towcester. Continue on A43 for 9 miles, take A413 towards Buckingham / Whittlebury following signs for Whittlebury Hall, after 2 miles turn right in to Whittlebury Park. Turn right at mini roundabout, follow signs for HCGB campsite & paddock.

Via M40:

At junction 10, take the A43/B430 exit to Northampton/Middleton Stoney. Continue on A43 for approx.. 13 miles then keep left on to A413 signposted Silverstone / Whittlebury. Straight ahead at mini roundabout, signposted Silverstone village, Whittlebury. At second mini roundabout turn right in to Whittlebury Road for 1.2 miles. Continue on Church Way for 0.3m, turn right in to High Street for 0.4m, turn right in to Whittlebury Park. Turn right at mini roundabout, follow signs for HCGB campsite & paddock.

There will be a one way system into the camping area as per the map. This is to be followed at all times asides for emergency vehicles.

Toilet and shower facilities are available **24/7** - see map for location

Food is available from Saturday morning through to Monday afternoon. Breakfast rolls, pastries, cakes and liquid refreshments throughout the day. Saturday evening there will be a mild meat chilli and a veg chilli with jacket potato and loaded nachos available as well as jacket potato with cheese, beans as an option. All will be available as gluten free and dairy free. Dessert will be apple crumble and custard, again, dietary options catered for. Sunday evening there will be BBQ food, burgers, chips/cheesy chips available (no need to book in advance)

PLEASE NOTE: during the paddock open periods, officials will be served as a priority for snacks and drinks due to time constraints.
